This statement covers our policy on general public access to the dam:

- Drax don't allow vehicle access to the dam for the general public, this is controlled by a gate that is kept locked. There are no restrictions for walkers and cyclists as there is a foot gate to the side of the locked gate.
- Drax don't permit vehicle access due the single-track road, livestock from the hill farm (not managed by us), and inclement weather conditions
- We must also highlight that St Conan's road is a residential area, with very limited parking for visitors.
- Cruachan Visitor Centre is the public domain of our pumped-storage hydroelectric power station. Please check current opening times.
- Cruachan Visitor Centre is situated on the north bank of Loch Awe, 19 miles east of Oban on the A85. Falls of Cruachan station is 200 metres away and served by trains between Glasgow and Oban. The Visitor Centre is also on Glasgow to Oban bus routes.
- The Cruachan Visitor Centre and Hollow Mountain Cafe have a free of charge car park for visitors to the centre.
- The visitor centre has a free interactive exhibition which helps explain the history of Cruachan.
